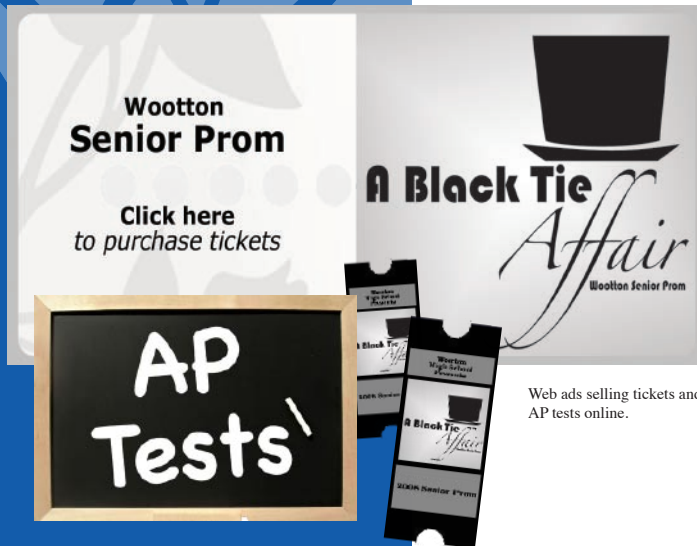


How a High School Managed Student Transactions with Fieldhouse

The Scenario

During previous years, Wootton High School struggled to manage student transactions. In 2007, they chose to use a Fieldhouse online store as a more efficient way to collect orders and payments. With very little setup time they were able to track sales of dance tickets, advanced placement (AP) tests and senior fees, and only eligible students were able to purchase. Wootton was pleased with Fieldhouse's services while students and parents commented on how easy the store was to use. In addition to managing student transactions, customized school gear was available online, making purchasing convenient 24/7.
